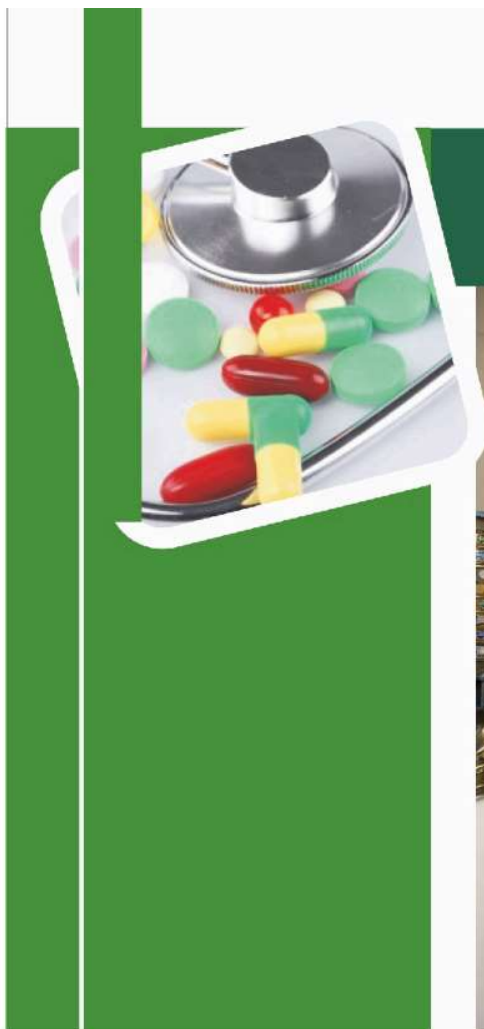

Pharmaceutics is the discipline of pharmacy that deals with the process of turning a new chemical entity (NCE) into a medication to be used safely and effectively by patients.

The Pharmaceutics laboratories are the state-of-the-art facility equipped with multiple processing analytical equipment which allow our students first hand practical training on pre-formulation testing, formulation and quality control testing of various dosage forms ranging from oral tablets to topical preparations and inhalation products. 1.2.2 PHARMACEUTICAL CHEMISTRY

The Pharmaceutical Chemistry laboratories are modern teaching facility fully equipped with fume hoods and other ancillary equipments to enable high-level teaching of organic, inorganic, analytical and medicinal chemistry.

Pharmaceutical Chemistry has 5 laboratories including instrumentation room. One laboratory is dedicated to inorganic and organic chemistry, second one dedicated to biochemistry & analytical chemistry, third laboratory is for medicinal chemistry and fourth one is for PG students.

The department provides extensive scope for practical training in pharmaceutical medicinal chemistry and synthetic chemistry with practical training exposure. 1.2.3 PHARMACOLOGY

The Pharmacology laboratories contain all essential equipments necessary to study the effects of drugs on isolated tissues and organs. Well equipped laboratories of pharmacology department train the students in practical studies of anatomy physiology and health education, pharmacology and chemotherapy, bioassays of various drugs, etc. Facilities of models and charts for human systems are installed and haematological experiments are performed in the laboratories. These laboratories are very well equipped and specially designed to carry out various in vitro experiments on isolated organs, tissues and cells. Bioassays and evaluation of drugs by various animal models like analgesics, anti-inflammatory, antidiabetic, antihypertensive, antiasthmatic, antipsychotic and anticancer are carried out in this laboratory. Software based experiments are also taught as per CPCSEA guidelines.

Pharmacognosy is the study of drugs in their crude condition. Study of Pharmacognosy would include the knowledge of drugs with reference to botany and chemistry, if of vegetable origin or of their zoology and chemistry if derived from the animal kingdom.

The infrastructure of the Department includes well equipped laboratory with all the facilities for isolation, characterization and estimation of phyto-constituents. It is meant to familiarize students about various plant families with charts and photographs of crude drugs for morphological studies, enriched with specimen of various medicinal plants and quantitative microscopy.

Rules & Regulation In College



All the boys/girls admission in of the mentioned courses are expected to follow the rules and regulations (subject to change by the colleges authorities)as mentioned below:

1. All the students will sign the declaration in the admission form that they have read the rules and regulations of the college and will comply with the same.
2. All students shall comply by the rules and regulations of Uttarakhand State University Act/ ordinances as from time to time.
3. It is mandatory that all the students attend all the lectures and participate in the extra curricular activities of the colleges. Students and parents should pay proper attention to complete the minimum attendance required to appear in the University examination.
4. Any student who remains absent, without any valid reason for more than six days from the class, his/her name will be struck off from the college rolls. However, he/she will be permitted to attend the classes by paying re-admission charges applicable.
5. It is the duty of students to attend all the important functions such as Independence Day/ Republic Day/Founder's Day or any other special occasion organized or celebrated by the colleges.
6. The progress of the students will be communicate to their parents/ Guardians regularly. Students, whose progress will not considered satisfactory, will not be allowed to appear in the University examinations.
7. All students will attend their Internal Exams conducted by the colleges. Parents/ Guardians are requested to pay full attention and most meet Principal as when called for, in the interest of their ward.
8. It is mandatory for all students to attend the college in uniform and strict to the dress code given in the prospectus.

13. If students lose or do any type of damage to any library book/books, they must either arrange to replace it with a new one at their own cost within one week or pay double the price of the book.
14. Students will have to pay for all damages caused by them to the instruments, equipments, or any other college property.
15. Students are advised to maintain the decorum of the college in the true spirit.
16. Ragging in any form is not allowed within and outside the college campus as per Supreme Court Ruling.
17. Student are not allowed to use the college/ office telephone for private use.
18. Mobile phones are strictly banned in college campus.
19. Matters not covered by the above rules, will fall entirely within the absolute discretion of management of the college.
20. All disputes will be settled in Dehradun jurisdiction only.
21. To provide ragging-free environment in the hostels, Wardens keep an eye on each & every student so that the student are aware of the consequences and keep themselves away from such activities.
